Lector: The world and all that is in it belong to Yahweh. Yahweh built it upon the deep waters, Laid its foundations in the oceans' depths.


People Respond: This is the People, O God, that longs to see your face.

Lector: A reading from Saint Paul's Second Letter to Timothy.

From Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus, by God's choosing, to Timothy, my beloved child in faith: May grace, mercy, and peace from God the Creator and Jesus the Christ be with you.


I am reminded of your sincere faith, a faith that lived first in your grand-mother Lois and your mother Eunice, a faith that now lives in you. For this reason, I remind you to keep aflame the gift of God that is within you through the laying on of my hands.

Remember, God gave us not a spirit of cowardice, but a spirit of action, love, and self-discipline. Do not be ashamed, then, of the testimony of Jesus who died on the cross, or of me who is in prison for his sake. Rather, join with me in suffering for the gospel, relying on the power of God, who delivered us, freed us, and called us with a holy calling.

For Christ put an end to death and revealed life everlasting through the gospel. For this gospel, I was appointed a herald and an apostle and a Teacher. And you, also, are called. Guard the good treasure entrusted to you. The Holy Spirit, who lives within us, will help you.

(Matthew 23:8-12 (CCL))


Celebrant: May the Word of Christ be with you all.


