Saint Martin of Tours is the first independent Catholic faith community in Franklin County, Vermont. St. Martin's is part of a vibrant movement known as the Independent Sacramental Movement that has emerged across the U.S. over the last 30 years. (Independent Catholicism has existed in Europe and South America for many decades).

We are:

clare bound on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you declare loosed on earth will be loosed in heaven."


Then Jesus strictly ordered the disciples not to tell anyone that He is the Messiah.
