Liturgy of the Word

First Reading

A Reading from the Book of Acts.

Lector: As the number of followers continued to grow, a dispute arose between the Hellenistic Jews and those who spoke Hebrew because local followers were neglecting to share the community's food and charity fairly with Hellenistic widows.

So the Twelve assembled the community of followers together so the matter could be discussed. They said: "It is not right for us to neglect the word of God to serve at tables. Sisters and brothers - Look around, from among your numbers, and select from among you seven reputable people from the community. They must be filled with the Spirit and full of wisdom, and we will appoint them to the task of taking care of our poor. This will permit us to concentrate on prayer and the ministry of God's word."

The proposal was acceptable to the whole community, so they chose Stephen, a man filled with faith and the Holy Spirit; also Philip, Prochorus, Nicanor, Timon, Parmenas, and Nicholas of Antioch, who had been a convert to Judaism. They presented them to the apostles, who prayed over them and laid hands on them.

The word of God continued to spread, and the number of the disciples in Jerusalem increased greatly; even a large group of Temple priests began believing in Jesus! Lector: Hear what the Spirit is saying to God's people.

People Respond: Thanks be to God.

Lector: The eyes of Yahweh look on those who stand in reverence; on those who hope in God's love, to rescue them from death, or keep them alive during famine.

People Respond: O God, let your mercy be on us, as we place our trust in you.

Second Reading

A Reading from First Epistle of Peter.

Lector: Beloved, come to Christ Jesus. He is like a living stone, rejected by mortals, but chosen by God and precious in His eyes. As his followers, you are like living stones. So, become a holy priesthood and allow God to use you to build a spiritual home. This way, you might offer spiritual sacrifices to God, through Christ Jesus.

For it says in Scripture: "Behold, I am laying a stone in Zion, a cornerstone, chosen and precious; and whoever believes in it shall not be put to shame."

You believe, so Jesus is precious to you, but those who do not believe will find Jesus like, "The stone which the builders rejected has become the cornerstone," and, at the same time, He will be "an obstacle and a stumbling block."

Those who stumble and fall are the disbelievers in God's word; it is their destiny to stumble and fall. But you are "a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people set apart to sing the praises" of the One who called you out of darkness, and into His wonderful, divine light.

Lector: Hear what the Spirit is saying

to God's people.

People Respond: Thanks be to God.

Celebrant: Al<mark>leluia, alleluia.</mark>

Celebrant: "I am the way, the truth and the life; no one comes to my Father, except through me."

A Reading from the Gospel according to John.

Celebrant: Our God is with you.

People Respond: And also, with you.

Celebrant: A reading from the Holy Gospel according to John.

People Resp<mark>ond: † Praise to you,</mark> Jesus the Christ.

Jesus said to his disciples: "Do not let your hearts be troubled. You have faith in God; have faith also in me. In my Father's house, there are many dwelling places. If there were not, would I have told you that I am going to prepare a place for you? I am indeed going to prepare a place for you, and then I will come back again to take you with me, so that where I am, there, you may also be. You know the way that leads to where I am going."

Amen, amen, I say to you, whoever believes in me will do the works that I do, and will do even greater things than these because I am going to the Father."

Celebrant: My friends, the Gospel of the Lord.

People Respond: Praise to you, Jesus the Christ.
