The proof that you are children of God is the fact that God has sent forth, into our hearts, the Spirit of the Child who calls out, "Abba, Father!"


You are no longer slaves but daughters and sons. And if you are daughters and sons, you are also heirs, by God's design.

Celebrant: May the Word of Christ be with you all.

The shepherds went in haste to Bethlehem and found Mary, Joseph, and the infant lying in the manger. When they saw this, they made known the message that had been told to them about the child.
